- Seven nights of accommodations at Alphonse Island Resort

- International flights to Mahe International Airport (SEZ)
- Per person (anglers and non-anglers) Alphonse Conservation Levy of \$175.00 (added to initial trip invoice)
- Any overnight hotel, taxi or other costs in Mahe
- Alcohol and other beverages at Alphonse Island Resort
- Incidentals and fly shop purchases on the island
- Gratuities for staff and guides
- Mandatory travel and medical evacuation insurance (available through Yellow Dog)

How To Get There

The primary airport and access hub for the Seychelles is the Mahe International Airport (SEZ). The Seychelles is served by several internationally scheduled flights, including direct services from London (Heathrow) with Air Seychelles, Paris with Air France, Johannesburg with Air Seychelles and Dubai with Emirates. From the U.S. you will typically fly to Paris, London or Dubai, and from there fly directly to Mahe (SEZ). Each flight is approximately 10 to 14 hours long. Guests should plan to arrive on Mahe the day before and overnight in order to catch the Saturday morning flight to Alphonse.

Arrival and Departure Details / Times

Guests should plan to arrive on Mahe the day before and overnight! The transfer flight departs Mahe at approximately 9:00 AM and arrives in Alphonse at 10:00 AM. On the following Saturday, you should plan your international flight to depart Mahe (SEZ) no earlier than 6:30 PM, which is not really a problem since most international flights depart between 9:00 PM and 11:00 PM.

Documents Required

All U.S. citizens are required to have a valid passport that does not expire within six (6) months of trips dates. Please be sure that your passport has at least two blank, unstamped pages remaining in back, and that it is not torn, delaminated, or damaged in any way. UK, US, EU and RSA passport holders do not require a visa for entering the country of the Seychelles for vacation purposes.

PLEASE NOTE: Alphonse will no longer allow clients board the IDC charter flight to Alphonse, Astove or Cosmoledo unless they have already submitted proof of applicable medevac coverage and that all the information regarding their medevac, emergency numbers and next of kin details are supplied to Yellow Dog and the operators before the trip. If an emergency arises, it is important to have this information 'at the ready' so the crew on location may assist in the best possible way.

Travel Arrangements

Luggage Weight Restrictions

The inner-island flight are private charters that are operated by IDC. For all of these transfer flight, the IDC will usually enforce the 15 kilograms (33 pounds) main luggage / 5 kilograms (11 pounds) hand luggage rule for all passengers boarding aircrafts to Alphonse Island, Farquhar, Cosmoledo and Astove Atolls. Passengers that fail to comply with the restrictions may be instructed to unpack their overweight luggage and may have to leave the unpacked goods in Mahe at their expense. Usually the IDC will not make any exceptions to this rule, as all flights to the outer islands and atolls fly full. Please be aware that there is not an option to pay 'overweight' baggage fees, as the aircrafts can only carry so much cargo.
